OFF Licence
Sections 17 to 20, Sale and Supply
of Alcohol Act 2012



Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **JOHNER LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **359 Dakins Road RD7 Masterton** and known as **JOHNER ESTATE**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a. alcohol must be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday - 10:00am to 5:00pm
 - I. The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons
 - II. Conditions prescribing steps to be taken by the licensee to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed: the Host Responsibility Policy must be displayed in view of the public
 - III. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample
- b. the following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: The Licensee or manager must ensure that:
 - I. Patrons do not become intoxicated and where intoxicated persons do present themselves, they are not served further alcohol
 - II. Statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors are observed at all times and evidence of age documents is requested where necessary.
 - III. Signs clearly stating the above requirements are placed at all points of sale.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- (a) Either—
 - (i) Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed or;
 - (ii) if has never been renewed before, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if has never been renewed before, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
